→ Significant work done by the Government and Team Europe partners on regional development.



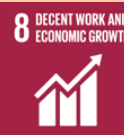
→ Joint regional development programme implementing the “Pilot Integrated Territorial Development Programme (PIRDP)” across regions of Georgia.
