Education



830,000+ refugee **children enrolled** in formal education (2023-24).



15,000+ students graduated from **vocational education**.



Almost **985,000** refugee children received **CCTE support** by the end of June 2024.



30,000+ students accessed **transportation services** in Q2 2024.



83,000+ students received **scholarships for technical or higher education**.



Almost **20,000** refugee children attended **Turkish language courses** in Q2 2024.



176 schools **constructed and put into use**.



53,000+ refugee students received **psycho-social support** in Q2 2024.



14,000+ education staff were **employed with EU support** in Q2 2024.



Almost **250,000** education personnel were **trained** since 2017.

Health



179 Migrant Health Centres operational in **32** provinces.



600+ healthcare facilities upgraded; **two** new hospitals are operational.



40 million+ primary healthcare consultations made for refugees.



Almost **10 million** vaccination doses administered to refugee children.



3,657 healthcare staff working in EU-supported facilities in June 2024.



13,000+ healthcare staff trained with EU support.

Livelihoods



76,000+ trained in vocational skills.



Almost **150,000** received employment counselling.



İŞKUR helped **18,000+** to find jobs; two-thirds from the host community, **31%** are women.



18,000+ obtained a certificate in a vocational skill area.



20,500+ secured jobs through EU-funded programmes; **56%** are refugees, **15%** are women.



1,600 craftsmen received financial or material support.



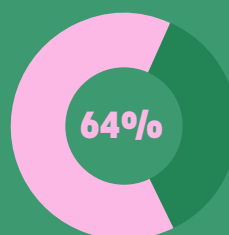
674 enterprises established or expanded, creating **15,000+** jobs.



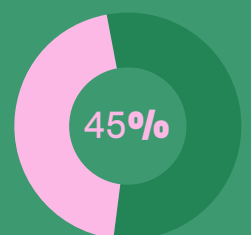
Nearly **8,000** provided with entrepreneurship training; **64%** are refugees, **45%** are women.

3.3 million+ refugees have benefited from protection services.

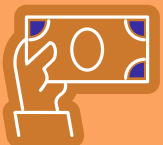


509 social services and migration management staff employed in Q2 2024.

Two sanitation facilities are operational, serving **180,000+**; **31** facilities underway.

Social Cohesion



Nearly **60,000** refugees have completed **Turkish language courses**.



900,000+ attended **social cohesion events** since 2017.
