Project Objectives

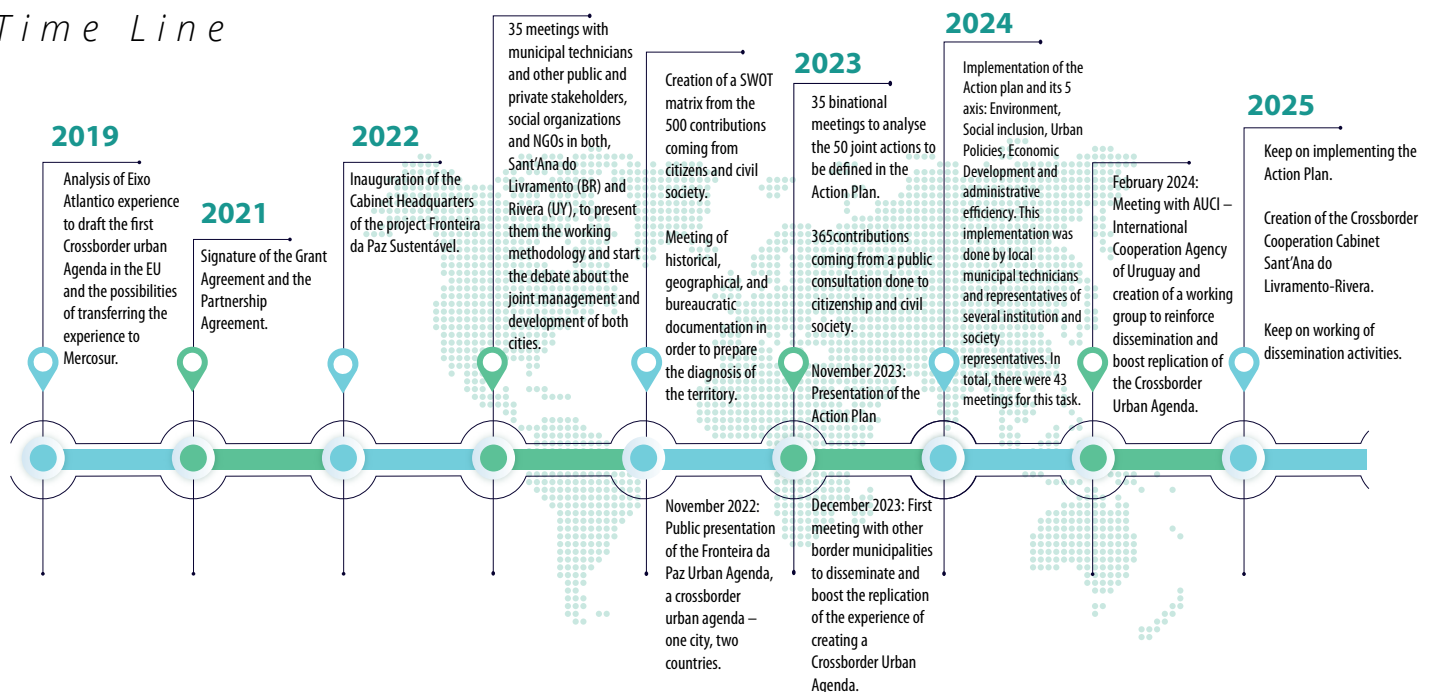
1. Promote the efficient management of public services and an integrated urban governance together with Rivera (Uruguay), using a Crossborder Urban Agenda.
2. Improve quality of life at the Border, implementing circular economy in the urban solid waste management, focused in social inclusion and sustainability.

1 - Urban Agenda and Action Plan at Fronteira da Paz

Drafting a Crossborder Urban Agenda (strategy) with a vision over a decade long, which identifies the main lines of development, not being conditioned to political cycles of the local administration. The Agenda is consolidated through its Action Plan, the document that guides the implementation of the strategy, identifying actions, measures and concrete projects, as well as human, technical and financial resources.

2 - URBAN SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT

Promotion of urban sustainability, circular economy and social inclusion in the Fronteira da Paz territory, thanks to a Solid Waste Management Plan done taking into account the needs of the public administration, citizens and informal waste collectors in this territory.

PROMOTED ACTIONS

- Solidarity Selective Waste Collection
- Promoting the collection, treatment and recovery of urban solid waste
- Improvement of the environmental impact
- Integration and improvement of socioeconomic condition of informal waste collectors, with especial attention to women.

INITIAL SITUATION

- Association with 5 informal waste collectors gathering 5 Tons per months of recyclable waste.

GOALS

- Positionate Fronteira da Paz as a regional reference in waste treatment and social inclusion.
- Strengthen the Collectors Association and structure public administration with trained technicians.
- Increase the quantity of waste collected and the number of collectors associated.

SOCIAL INCLUSION APPROACH

This project aims to dignify and valorize the work of collectors, improving their living conditions and promoting their socioeconomic integration in the community..
